The training curriculum includes basics of social and personality development as well as childfriendly communication skills which may help to develope a truly child-sensitive, child rights-based approach. In addition, the programme provides a detailed and in-depth knowledge of the universal and regional international legal background on children's rights and presents the full regulatory background for children, both from the field of public and private law, through a Central European comparative law perspective.


